Leading Australian Fly-in Fly-out (FIFO) and Air Cargo Operator to use the Aircraft for Qantas on Australia Post Contract

"The ATR 72 LCD presents a significant opportunity for Aerlink, allowing us to diversify our offering in Australia and the wider region, which is evident in our ability to secure contracts with Qantas and Australia Post" remarked Ann Elliott – Aerlink's CEO. "We're delighted to continue our relationship with ACIA and expanding our portfolio of leased ATR aircraft from them. In today's 'supply challenged' environment, they have delivered a high quality aircraft on time for our contract commencement".

The ATR 72 LCD converted freighters are the perfect match for Aerlink's cargo operations, setting the benchmark in terms of efficiency, reliability, and economics in this market segment. With excellent performance and higher capacity cargo uplift even on shorter operating field, these aircraft will enable Aerlink to land at smaller, unpaved runways, inaccessible by larger freighter aircraft, across Australia Post's route network. ATR turboprop aircraft are also recognized as the most eco-friendly regional aircraft, delivering maximum operational flexibility and environmental efficiency.

"We see strong demand for regional freighters, especially the ATR 72 Family, because of the type's ability to serve remote regions and challenging airfields. ACIA continues to be the leader in turboprop freighter conversions, and we expect to be at the forefront meeting this market demand into the future" stated Mick Mooney, ACIA's Chief Executive Officer. "Aerlink continues to be a key customer for ACIA and we're delighted to continue building our relationship with the Aerlink team and expanding our leased fleet with them".
